Unless the poor are economically empowered, their lives and communities remain blighted by poverty, and dependent on ongoing aid where and when it is offered. A much fuller New Testament understanding of Jesus' Kingdom gospel, and the power of the Holy Spirit, reveals the economic potential of the gospel to lift poor people sustainably out of poverty.

Bruce will develop this theme, and illustrate it with Just Earth, a movement that integrates evangelism, discipling, wealth creation and community transformation through church-recruited and pastored Farm Schools.

Our festival fees only cover this event, not the leaders' days, retreats, weekend conferences, worship events or leader development work we do. God's provision comes through your generosity.

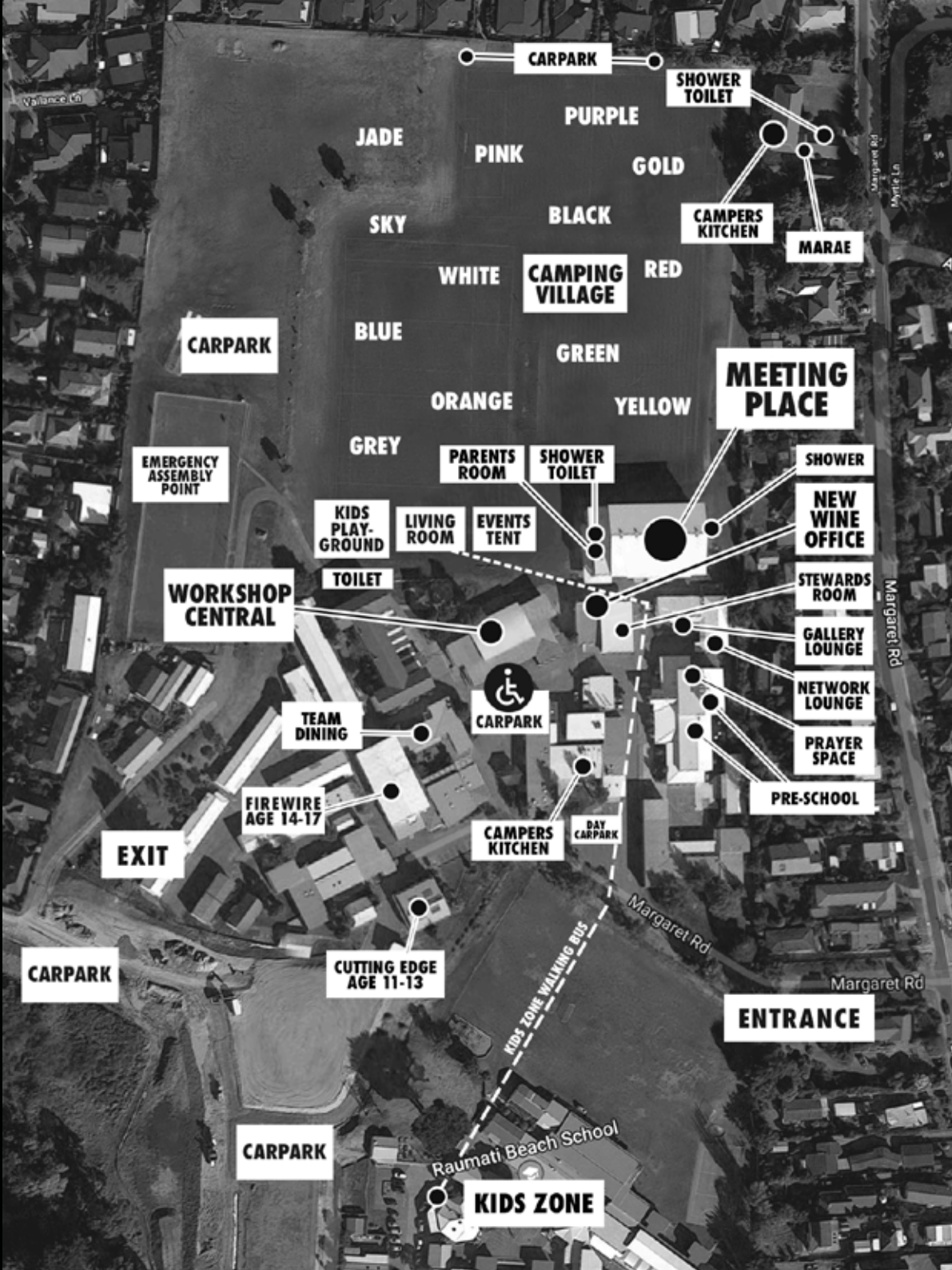
